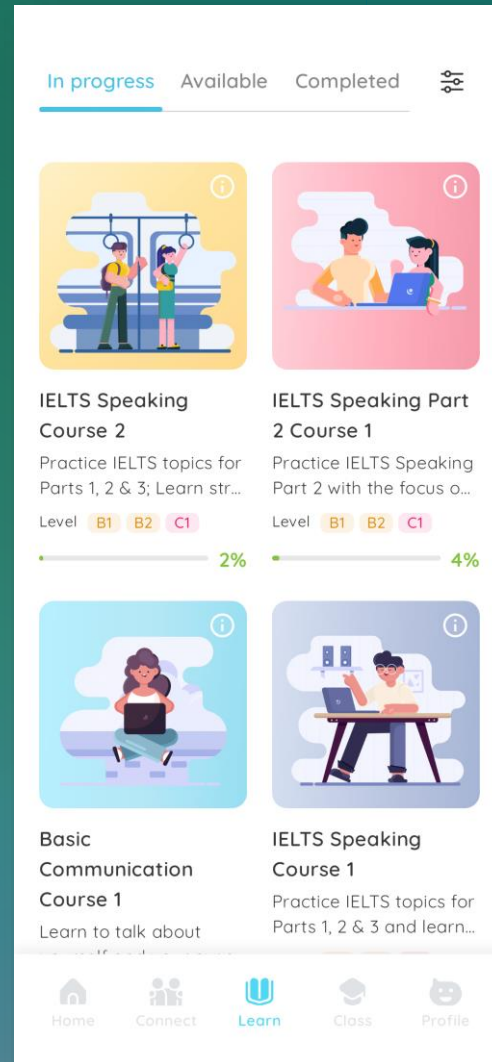
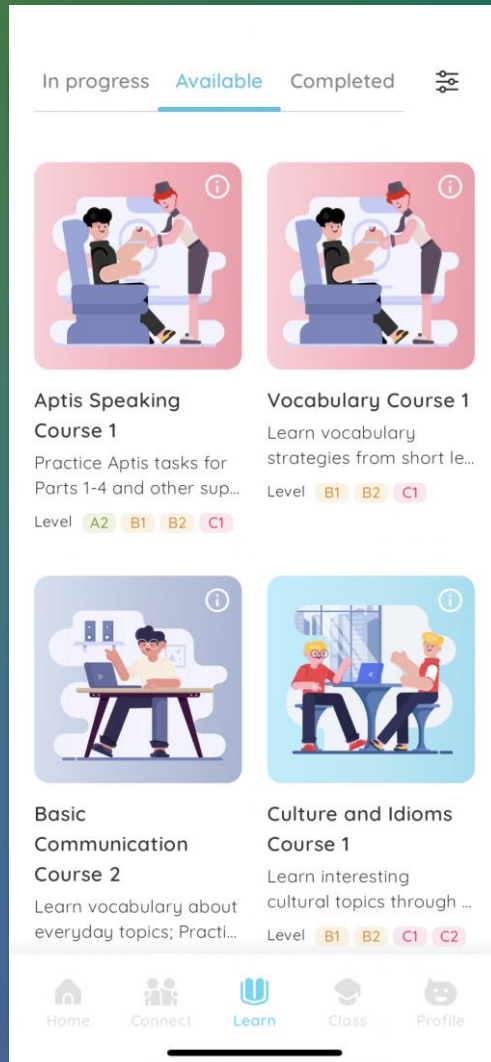
The home screen of the app
